

# Statement of Compliance

## The Electric Vehicles (Smart Charge Points) Regulations 2021

The Electric Vehicles (Smart Charge Points) Regulations 2021 (“the Regulations”) require the seller to provide a statement of compliance with the sale of any relevant charge point in meeting the requirements of Regulation 13.
